## ***Our Services:***

***We offer the following services for individuals, families and school districts:***

### **Assessment:**

We offer diagnostic assessment services to individuals who are suspected of having an ASD or other developmental disability. Assessments are conducted and/or supervised by a licensed psychologist, using standardized test measures designed to assist in accurate diagnosis and to evaluate developmental, cognitive, and behavioral functioning.

### **Home and School-Based Intervention:**

Techniques are utilized to help individuals improve learning, scheduling, transitioning, communication, and socialization.

### **Social/Sensory Enrichment Programs:**

Throughout the school year and summer, programs are provided to increase social skills and assist with sensory dysfunction.

### **Case Management:**

We strive to connect children and families to services provided by Woodland Centers and community partners.



### **Parenting Support:**

We offer parent support groups to help parents connect with others and learn new skills.

### **Training/Community Education:**

We provide training to educators, parents, and the communities we serve. Trainings are based on needs of staff and the community and aim to train others to help individuals with ASD reach their fullest potential.
